Events are important activities to residents and tourists in Copper Corridor communities. Events are also a strong segment of the tourism and recreation sector of the economy. Events attract tourists to the community who then spend in local economies and stay overnight. The results of research on four primary events in the Copper Corridor communities provide an overview of the tourism potential that could be further developed.
