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Introduction

In Fall of 2011, ASU's Partnership for Community Development (PCD) entered into a collaboration with Valley of the Sun United Way (VSUW) to conduct a community scan to inform the Balsz Promise Neighborhood initiative. The vision of the Balsz Promise Neighborhood initiative is to create "a comprehensive and seamless cradle-to-college-to-career continuum to improve educational and developmental outcomes for the children and youth of the community."¹

A fundamental tenet of the emerging vision was that all elements of the Balsz community must be engaged if the educational and developmental outcomes of education are to be maximized. Thus, the responsibility for building a thriving learning environment rests not solely with the schools, but with the entire community. There are many players: individuals, families, businesses, faith communities, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, service clubs, and many other community-based organizations. As the old adage goes, "It takes a whole community to make a community whole." The basic premise is that that all aspects of community life – and all the individuals and organizations within it – boldly shape the destiny of the children and youth of a community.

Many partners were assembled to provide leadership for this Balsz Promise Neighborhood initiative. These included but were not limited to Valley of the Sun United Way, Balsz Elementary School District (BESD), Communities in Schools AZ, Camelback High School, GateWay Early College High School, Gateway Community College, Educare Arizona, ASU – Partnership for Community Development, ASU - Educational Outreach and Student Services, KAET - Channel 8 Educational Outreach – ASSET, Chicanos Por La Causa, City of Phoenix Department of Human Services, City of Phoenix Department of Neighborhood Services, the Lindon Park and the Greater Orangedale Neighborhood Associations, Boys & Girls Club of Metropolitan Phoenix, Southwest Human Development, Literacy Volunteers of Maricopa County, and UMOM New Day center. The partnership structure continues to expand over time with an ever-increasing roster, and emerging support from entities such as Ellis Center for Educational Excellence, Apollo Group/University of Phoenix, Stardust Foundation, Desert Schools Federal Credit Union, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Children and Families and others.

The ASU Partnership for Community Development's Balsz Community Scan was commissioned by VSUW to gain perspective on community assets and challenges, as well as what the Balsz community senses are barriers and opportunities for enhancing the educational and developmental outcomes for its children and youth. VSUW and the PCD elected to use an Asset-Based Community Development (ABCD) model for conducting the scan, which is designed "to empower the community to establish its own vision."²

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The ABCD model assumes that the answers for community challenges rest in the community, and not within institutions and traditional community service structures. While realistically identifying and addressing challenges within any given community, the focus is on identifying and organizing the many gifts and assets that abound within every community – challenged or not. This perspective is ultimately used to select and implement effective community development strategies that both meet community needs and build on community strengths.

This report serves as Part C of the community scan. It is primarily a repository of key statistical data that summarizes the socio-demographic structure of the Balsz community, as well as key institutional and organizational assets of the community – including but not limited to educational organizations, faith communities, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, businesses, service clubs and other community-based organizations. It can thus serve as a primer for quickly assembling insight on the residents, organizations and land use patterns that give shape to the community. The section on community assets, in particular can be used to identify potential partnerships that can move the community forward in achieving its Promise Neighborhood vision. All data in this report are derived from secondary data sources such as the U.S. Census, the American Community Survey, the Guidestar inventory of nonprofit organizations, and the business index from MelissaDATA.

For data compilation purposes, the boundaries of the Balsz community are defined by the boundaries of the Balsz Elementary School District boundaries (see Figure 1. on page 14 of this report). Much of the community falls within the 85008 zip code designated by the U.S. Postal Service, yet there are sections of zip code 85018 (northern boundary) and 85034 (southern boundary) from which data were drawn. In nearly all cases BESD boundaries were utilized for data sets. Instances where data could not appropriately be disaggregated according to boundaries are so noted in the text.

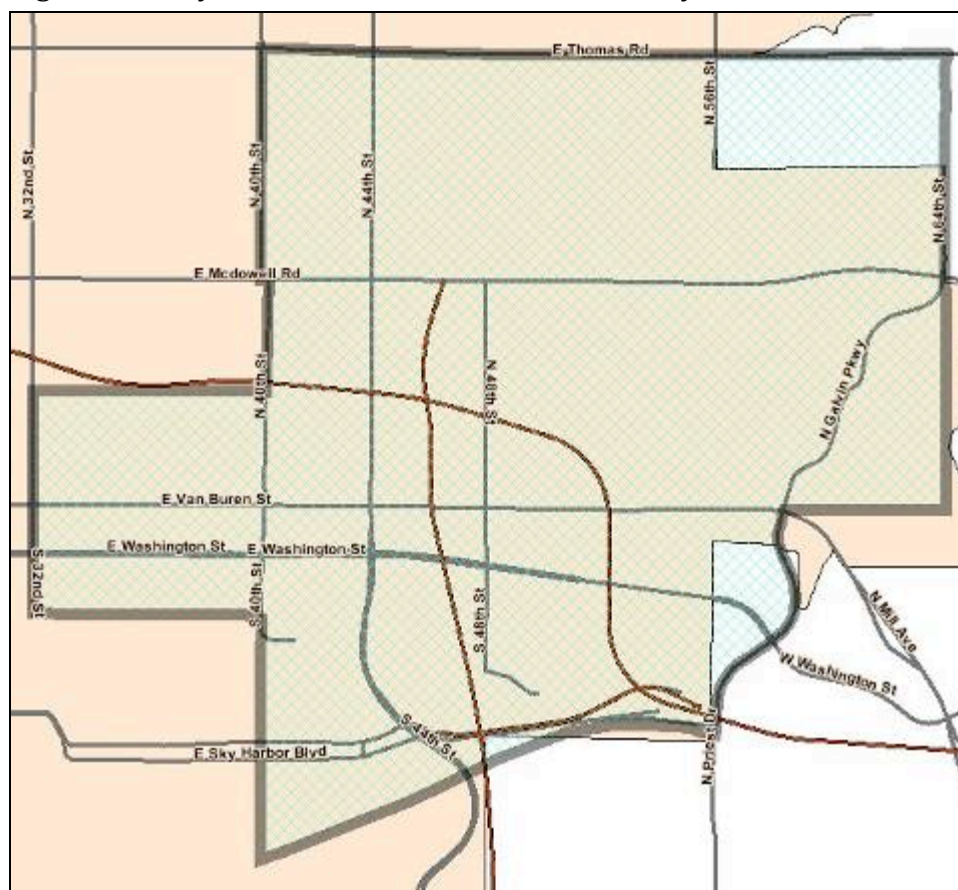

BESD Boundaries

Depicted below (Figure 1) are the boundaries of the Balsz Elementary School District, framing the context for all data contained in this report. Figure 2 depicts the neighborhoods served by each public school in the community.

The community is situated approximately four miles east of downtown Phoenix, Arizona. Its western most border is N. 32nd Street, and the eastern most border is N. 60th Street. The northern border generally follows the Grand Canal from N. 32nd Street to N. 40th Street, and then follows Thomas Road eastwardly to N. 60th Street. The Southern border generally abuts the southeastern corner of Sky Harbor International Airport and then follows the Salt River east to the City of Tempe's N. Priest Drive. Then, the border generally follows the boundary between the City of Tempe and the City of Phoenix to N. 60th Street.

Figure 1. Study Boundaries – the Balsz Elementary School District



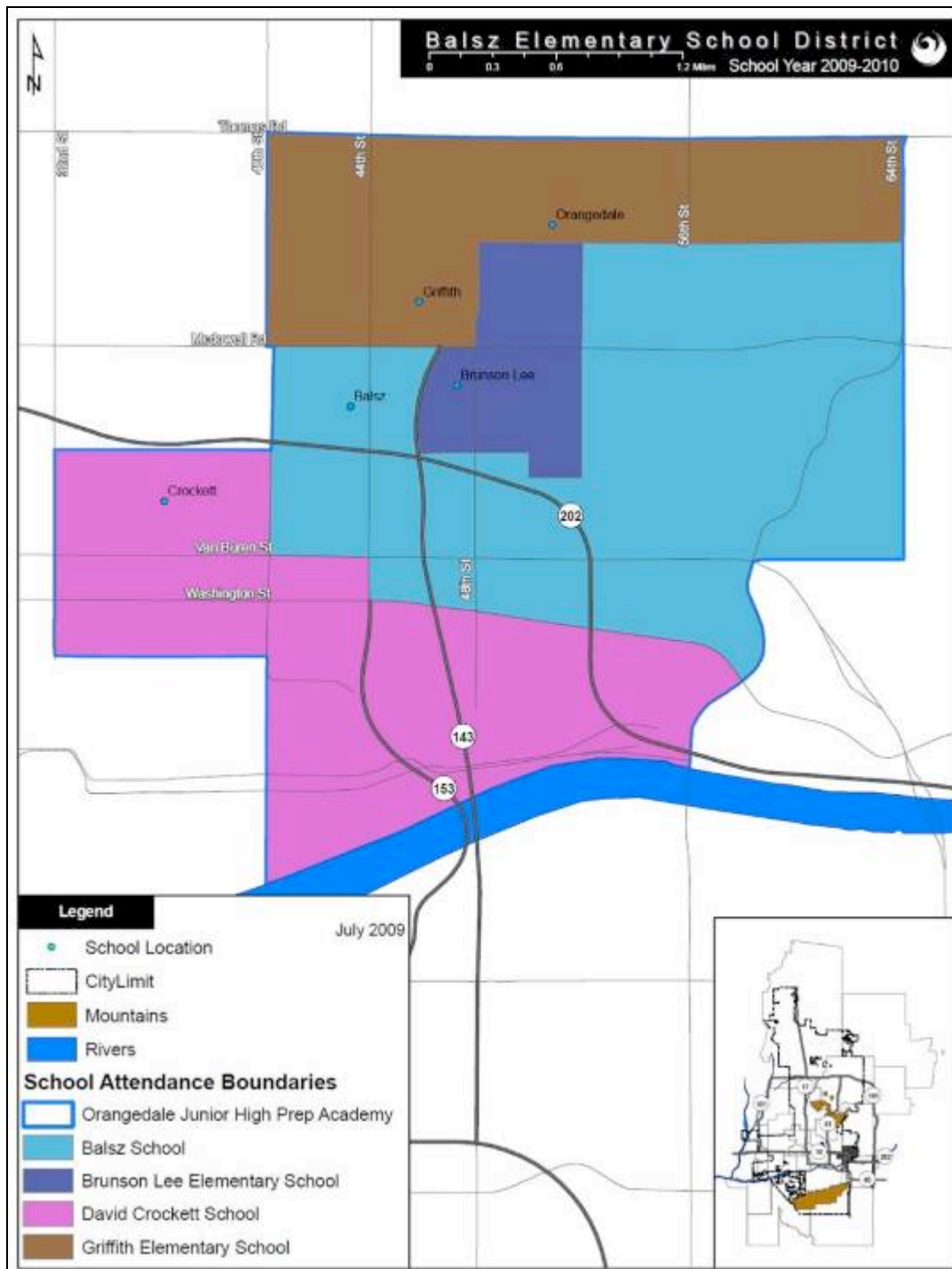

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Part I: Community Vital Signs

Much of the socio-demographic information in this section was extracted from U.S. Census and American Community Survey data sets for 2010. The core demographic statistics pertain to the community within the boundaries of the Balsz Elementary School District (BESD).

It is important to note that U.S. Census data is based on total community sampling, while the more extensive American Community Survey data is based on compilations of community sub-samples. Other forms of information – such as that on public transportation, housing, infrastructure, land use and zoning – were acquired from the City of Phoenix Planning and Development Department and other City of Phoenix Departments. School performance data was obtained from the Arizona Department of Education.

(1) Demographics

Age Distribution

- There are 29,036 residents within the Balsz Elementary School District. Their ages range from children under 5 years of age to adults over 65 years old. Twenty-nine percent of the population is 19 years or younger. Nearly seven percent (6.8%) of the population is older than 65 years of age.

Ethnicity and Race

- The largest ethnic group represented in the Balsz neighborhood is Hispanic, comprising approximately forty-four percent (44.4%) of the population.
- Individuals who identify themselves as Non-Hispanic White comprise 36.1% of the population.
- Individuals who identify themselves as Non-Hispanic Black comprise 11.3% of the population.
- Individuals who identify themselves as American Indian / Alaska Native comprise 4.0% of the population.
- Individuals who identify themselves as Asian make up 2.2% of the population.

Grandparents Raising Grandchildren

- Less than 2% of grandparents in the Balsz neighborhood live with their grandchildren under 18, and even less (< 0.1 %) are responsible for those grandchildren. 66.7% of those who care for their grandchildren are women. Of the 10 men that specified in the American Community Survey that they cared for grandchildren, only one is married.

Level of Education

- For the population over 25 years of age (over 75% of the population), 12.7% have less than a 9th grade education, 8.8% have had some high school but no diploma, and 23.7% have a high school diploma only.

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Veteran Status

- Based upon the 2010 American Community Survey, 7.5% of the individuals in the community (1,506 individuals) are civilian veterans (error estimate = +/-1.2%).

Residency

- Balsz residents tend to stay in the neighborhood. In 2010, 73.8% of the residents of Balsz had resided in the neighborhood for at least one year. Just under 25% of the residents of Balsz had moved into the neighborhood since 2009. Around 20% moved from within Maricopa County, and less than 10% moved from outside Maricopa County.

Household Composition

- The average household has just over 2 persons (mean of 2.35).
- Family households represent the largest proportion of households (47.8%). 55.5% of these households are headed by both a husband and a wife, 53.8% are headed by single mothers, and 15.2% of these households are headed by single fathers.
- The average family has just over 3 members (mean of 3.33).
- 29.1% of households contain individuals under the age of 18.
- 12.9% of households contain individuals that are 65 years and older.

Access to Public Transportation

Valley Metro provides the community with mass transportation connectedness to the greater metropolitan area (see www.valleymetro.org). The community is served by both and bus transportation.

Valley METRO Light Rail Service

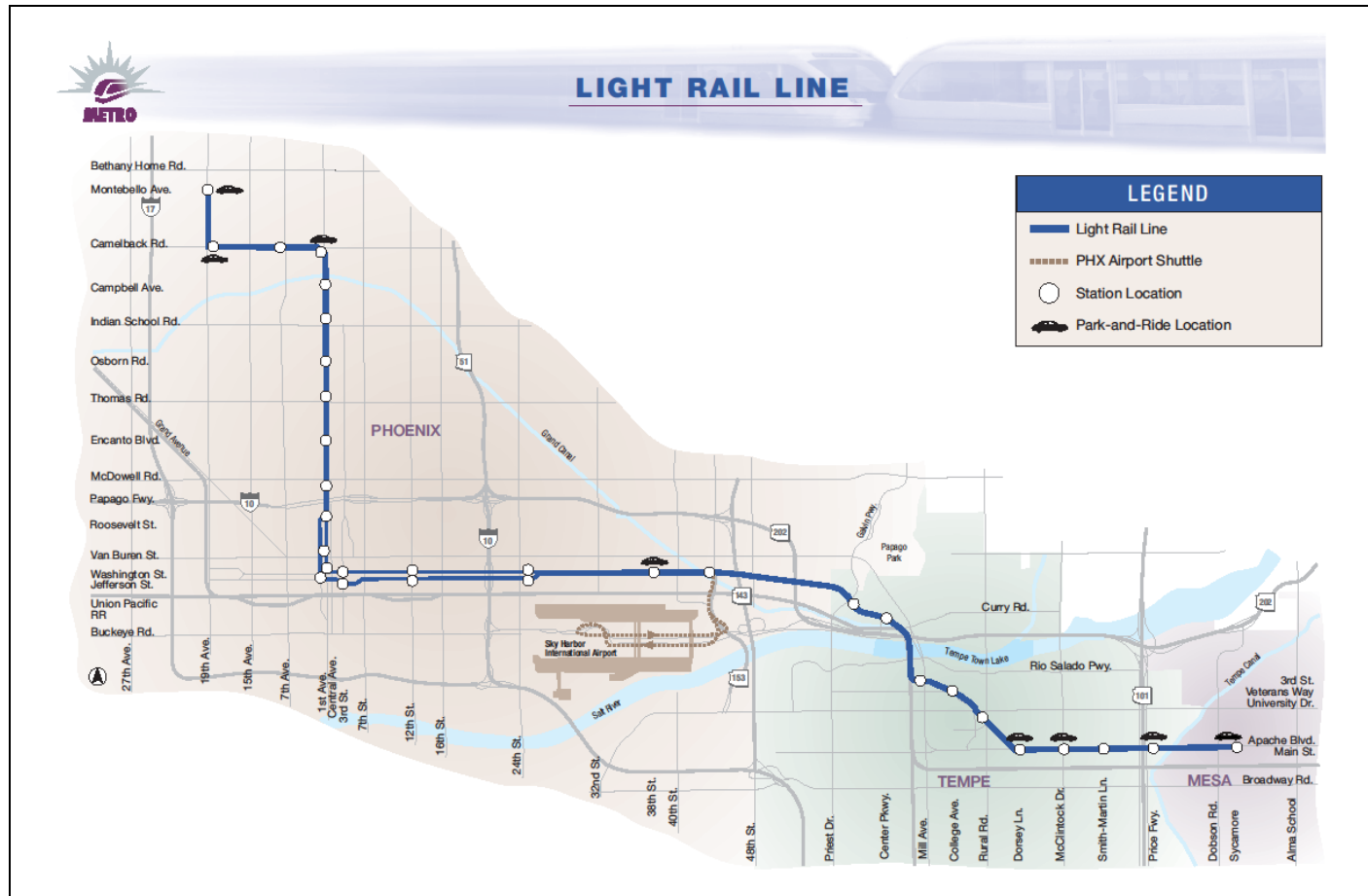
- The METRO Light Rail runs on an east-west track through the community along the Washington Street corridor (Figure 3).
- For 2012, METRO Light Rail fares are \$1.75 for a 1-Ride pass, \$3.50 for an All-day pass, \$5.25 for an All-day pass (on-board bus), \$10.50 for a 3-day pass, \$17.50 for a 7-day pass, and \$55.00 for a 31-day pass.
- Eastbound service begins at 4:14 am and ends at 12:49 am and westbound service begins at 3:55 am and ends at 12:25 am Monday through Thursday and Sunday. On Friday and Saturday, service ends at 3:49am.
- The major point of accessibility for the community is the 44th St & Washington St station
- To the West, the Light Rail provides access to downtown Phoenix and beyond to the 19th Avenue and Bethany Home area. To the East, it provides access to downtown Tempe and west to Mesa.
- Stations include Main & Sycamore, Apache Blvd & Price Rd, University Dr. & Rural Rd, Veterans Way & College Ave, Mill Ave & 3rd St, 44th St & Washington St, Central Ave & Van Buren St, Central Ave & McDowell Rd, Central Ave & Thomas Rd, Central Ave & Indian School Rd, Central Ave & Camelback Rd, 19th Ave & Montebello Ave.
- A Park-and-Ride station is located at the NW corner of 38th Street & Washington Street; however, there are no buses through the neighborhood to the station.

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Valley Metro Bus Service

- For 2012, Valley Metro Local bus route fares are \$1.75 for a 1-Ride pass, \$3.50 for an all-day pass, \$5.25 for an all-day pass (on-board bus), and \$10.50 for a 3-day pass.
- Bus Route 1 operates daily along Jefferson St/Washington St to and from Phoenix Zoo and 27th Ave. The bus runs every hour from 5:05am to 9:34pm Monday through Friday and Saturday and Sunday from 6:03am to 9:30pm.
- Bus Route 3 operates daily along Van Buren St from Phoenix Zoo to Central Ave. The bus runs every 30 minutes from 5:08am to 10:44pm weekdays and 5:30am to 9:23pm Saturdays and Sundays.
- Bus Route 17 operates daily along McDowell Rd from 83rd Ave in Phoenix to McClintock in Scottsdale. The bus runs weekdays from 5:06am to 11:01pm every 30 minutes and Saturday through Sunday from 5:40am to 9:12pm approximately every 30 minutes.
- Bus Route 29 operates daily along Thomas Rd from 91st Ave in Phoenix to Miller Rd in Scottsdale. The bus runs weekdays from 5:14am to 11:25pm approximately every 15 minutes and Saturday through Sunday from 7:23am to 10:33pm approximately every 15 minutes.
- Bus Route 44 operates daily along 44th St from University Dr. in Tempe to Deer Valley in North Phoenix. The bus runs every thirty minutes from 5:13am to 9:59pm weekdays and from 6:21am to 9:22pm Saturday and Sunday.
- Express Route 510 operates daily along 52nd St, McDowell Rd and 64th St every 5 to 10 minutes.
- All public transportation routes link up to a network of routes (as well as light rail) offering good access to most portions of the metropolitan area.
- There are no local neighborhood circulators within the community.

(5) Infrastructure

Embedded within the heart of one of the nation's largest cities, the community is supported by excellent urban infrastructure.

- Water, sanitary sewer, trash pickup and recycling pickup from the City of Phoenix are available throughout the community.
- Electricity is supplied by APS in the eastern portion of the community, and by SRP in the western portion of the community.
- There are no documented unique storm drainage issues in the community.
- There are no unpaved full streets in the community; some half streets remain unpaved.
- Traffic counts indicate that none of the community's streets exceed their functional classification (<http://phoenix.gov/streets/traffic/volumemap>).
- The community was developed on a grid street pattern. The major east-west arterial roads running through the center of the community are McDowell Street, Van Buren Street and Washington Street, with McDowell Street having direct connection the State Highway 143 Freeway. Thomas Street is another east west arterial that borders the community on the north side.
- Major north-south arterial roads include 32nd, 40th, 48th and 60th Streets. Connection to the State Highway 143 and Loop 202 (Papago) freeways is provided by 48th Street.

(6) Land Use and Zoning

Land Use Classification

The City of Phoenix provides an interactive mapping service for determining land use zoning for any parcel in the community (<http://maps.phoenix.gov/WebPMO/Portal/PlanningZoning.asp>). A broader view of the zoning classifications within the community is presented in Figures 4-7 below, preceded by the City of Phoenix key to the classification codes (Table 42). They reproduce information about zoning quadrants G10, G11, F10, and F11 of the City of Phoenix zoning classification map, representing the four zoning quadrants comprising the community (<http://maps.phoenix.gov/WebPMO/Portal/PlanningZoning.asp>).

It is important to note that underlying zoning requirements may not in fact perfectly represent current land use. For example, there are instances where single-family homes exist on parcels zoned for multiple family residences. In such cases, developers have the potential for re-constituting land use to fit the available zoning classification.

- Much of the community north of Van Buren Street has residential zoning (R-1, R-2, R-3, R-3A, R-4, R-4A, and R-5). However, looking at the whole of the community, there are also large blocks of Commercial (C-1, C-2, C-3) and Industrial (A-1, A-2) zoning as well.

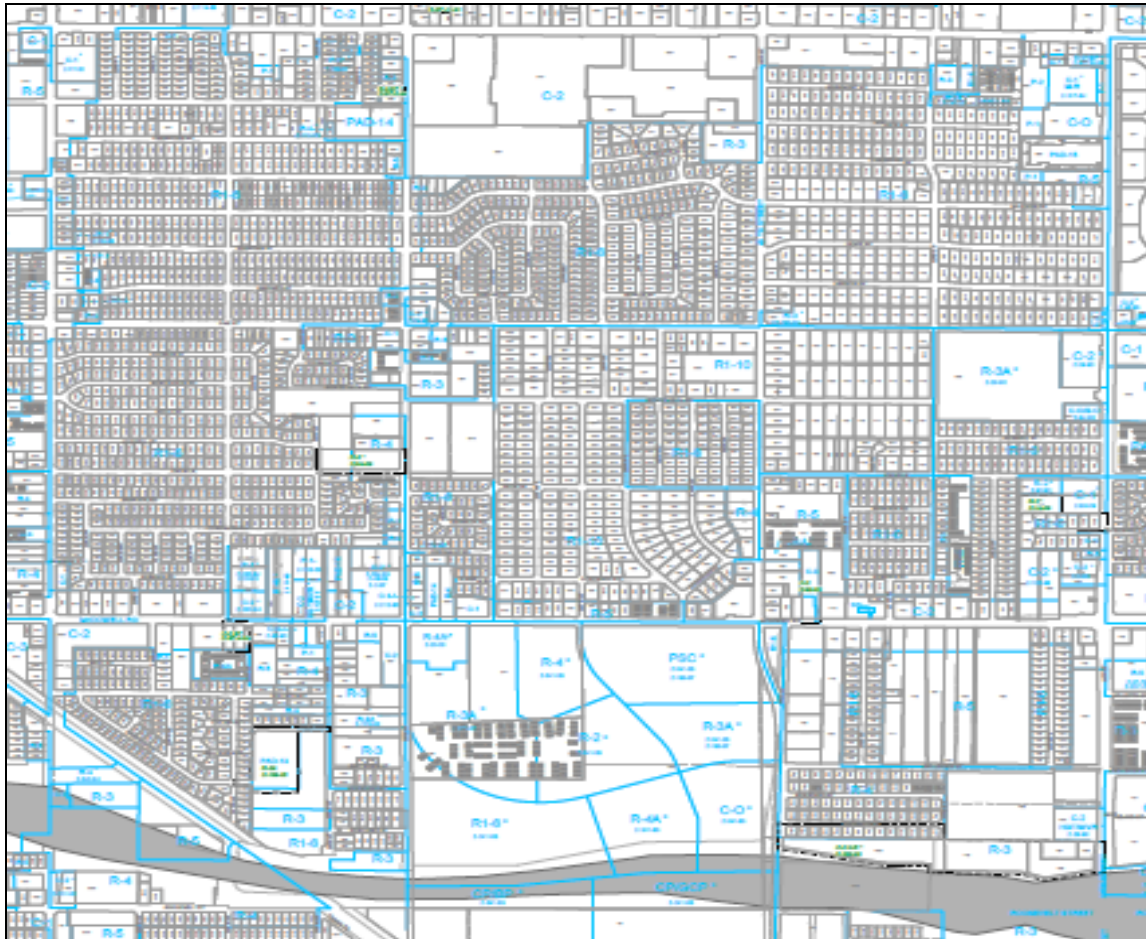
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- The commercial areas are primarily along the main arterial streets with some businesses scattered throughout the core of the community. Much of the southern portion of the community (generally south of Van Buren Street) is commercial and Industrial.
- Large areas of zoning for multiple family residents are evenly distributed around the community with the northwestern portion of community having the least amount of multiple family residences.
- The industrial areas are largely in the southern part of the community. Locations include the intersection of 40th Street and Grand Canal, between McDowell Road and Van Buren off of 52nd Street, and in general, south of Van Buren Street.
- There are a total of nine zoning reclassification changes that have been approved, but not yet been adopted. These are the dotted lines in Figures 4-7.

Figure 4. Zoning Classifications: Northwest Quadrant of the Balsz Community



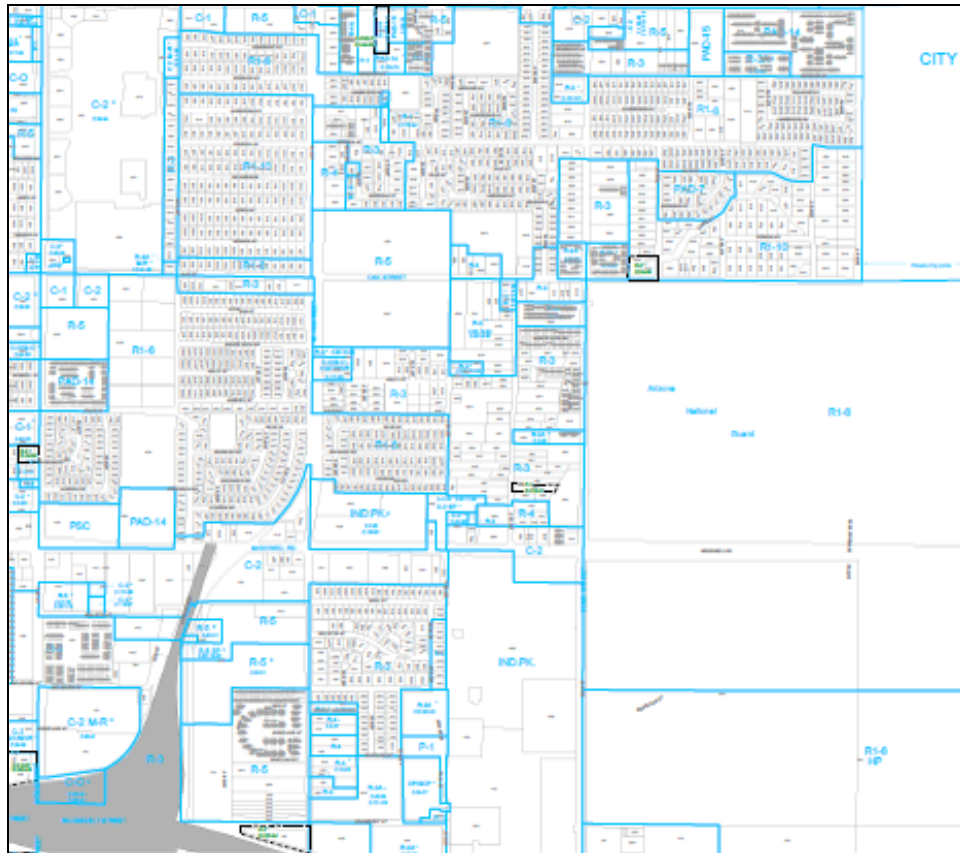

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Figure 5. Zoning Classifications: Northeast Quadrant of the Balsz Community



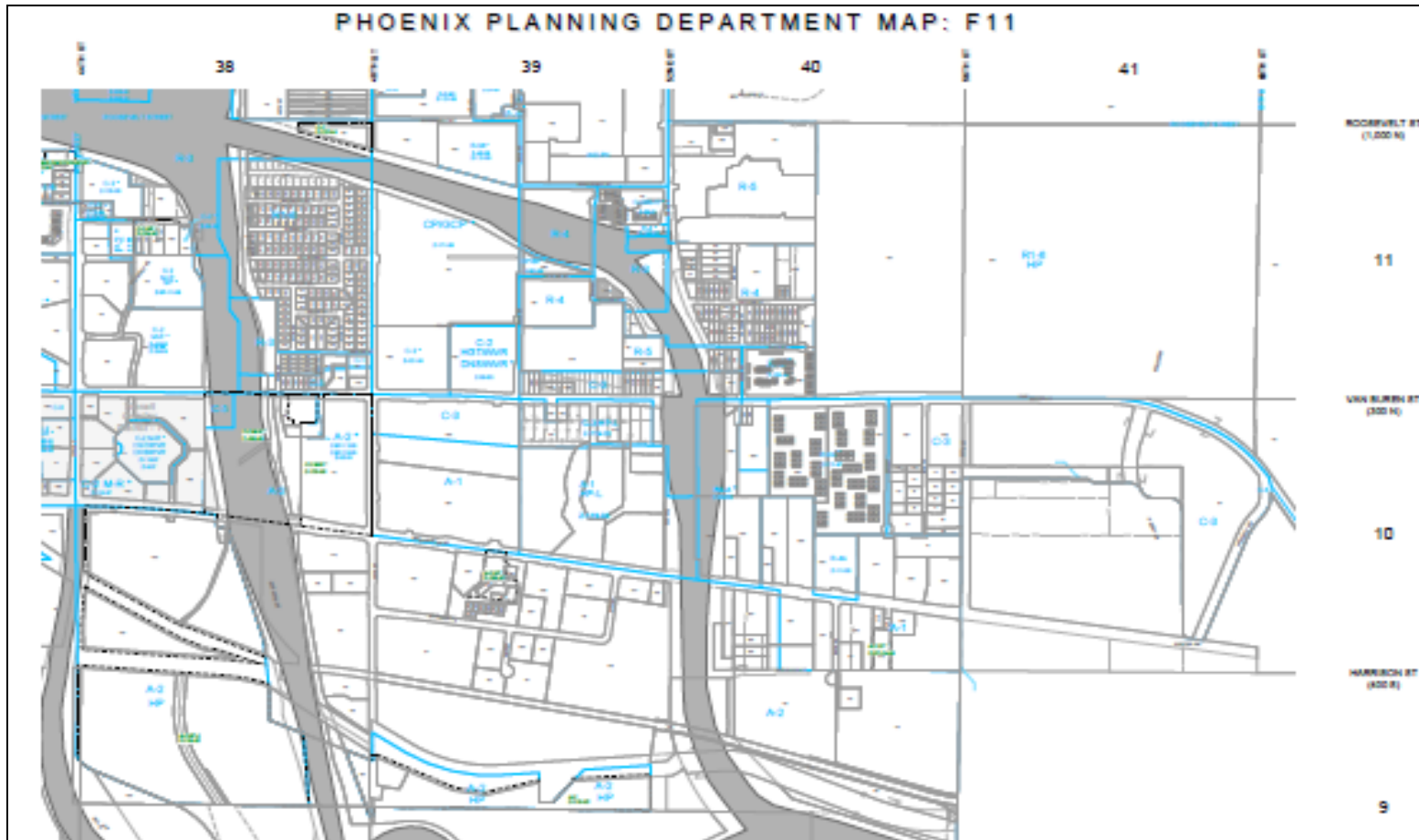

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Figure 6. Zoning Classifications: Southwest Quadrant of the Balsz Community



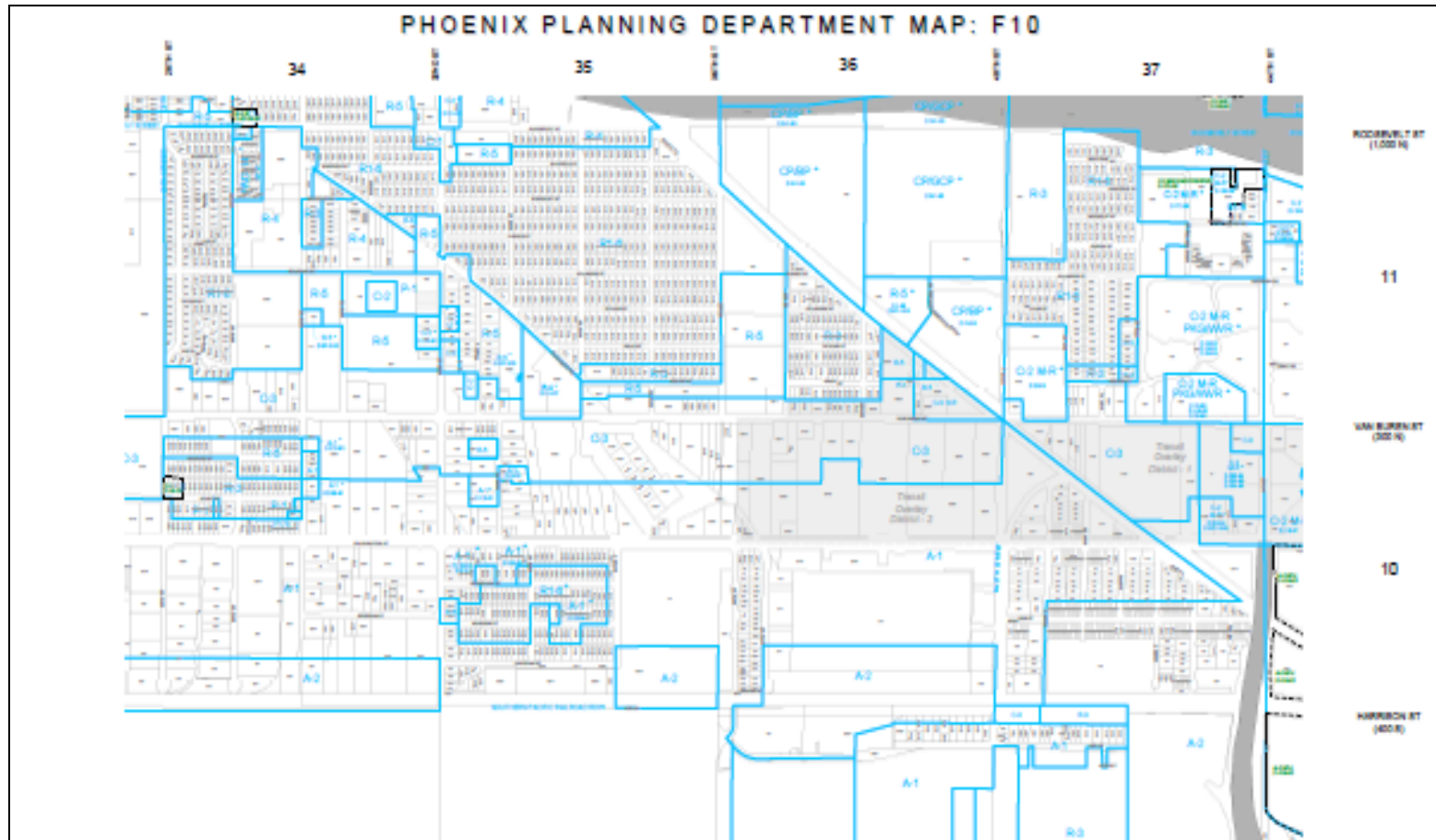

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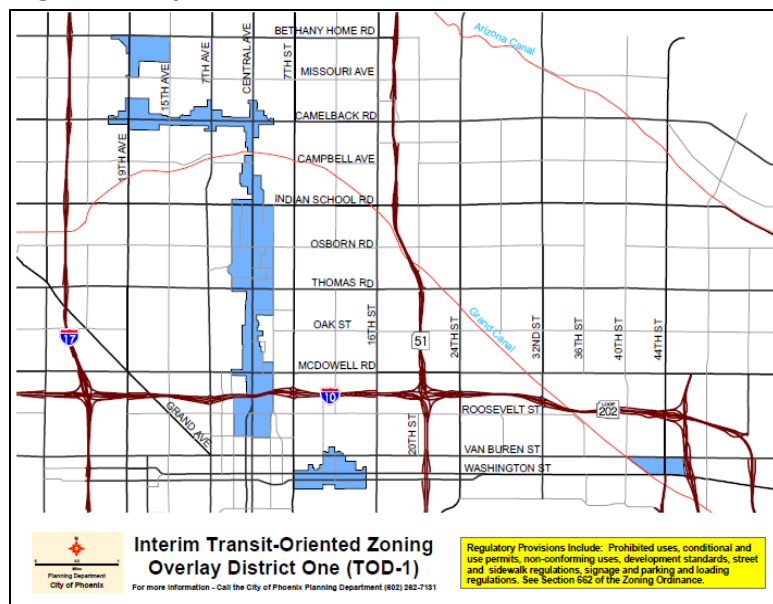

Transit Oriented Overlay Zoning

The City of Phoenix works with private developers to add transit infrastructure to new development in the city. Development proceeds in accordance with specifications of City of Phoenix prescribed by various Districts overlaying the City. The Balsz community resides within two of these Districts – Districts One and Two.

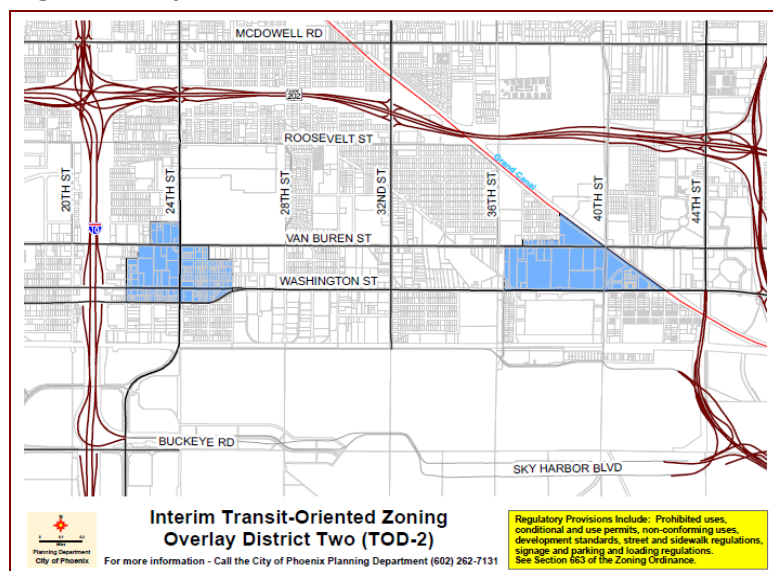
- Most of the community is within the City of Phoenix’s Interim Transit-Oriented District One (See Figure 8 below). These regulations seek to achieve this type of development by providing a pedestrian, bicycle, and transit supportive environment development integrating auto uses with a complementary mix of land uses, where streets have a high level of connectivity and the blocks are small, all within a comfortable walking and bicycling distance from light rail stations. (Section 662 of the City of Phoenix Zoning Ordinance).
- All of the community west of 44th Street and south of McDowell Road is part of the Interim Transit-Oriented Zoning Overlay District Two (See Figure 9).
- The primary purpose of the Interim Transit-Oriented District Two is to encourage an appropriate mixture and density of activity around transit stations to increase ridership along the Central Phoenix/East Valley (CP/EV) Light Rail Corridor and promote alternative modes of transportation to the automobile. The secondary purpose of the TOD-2 is to decrease auto-dependency, and mitigate the effects of congestion and pollution. (Section 663 of the City of Phoenix Zoning Ordinance).

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(7) Crime

The City of Phoenix Police Department is developing an on-line crime-mapping tool that will enable the community to filter local data by crime type, date, location and other details. Community members will also be able to view graphs and analyses of the data, sign up to receive email crime alerts, and submit tips to the police. The interactive tool will use the RAIDS online system, and will serve as a component of a national crime tracking system available to the public. The tool should be available to the community by the end of 2012.

At the time of this report, the City of Phoenix required a public records request to secure data to crime statistics at the precinct and beat level. Selected measures for the 2011 calendar year have been made available to the community through this process, and are reported in the tables below.

- In general, per capita violent crime rates for 2011 ran 23.6% higher than that for the City of Phoenix as a whole (6.4 per 1000 residents vs. 5.5 citywide).
- In general, per capita property crime rates for 2011 ran 20.2% higher than that for the City of Phoenix as a whole (53.0 per 1000 residents vs. 43.1 citywide).
- Specific crime measures that are particularly higher than that for the entire city include: motor vehicle theft (35.3% - 3.7 per 1000 residents vs. 2.8 citywide), aggravated assault (32.1% - 6.9 per 1000 residents vs. 5.1 citywide), and prostitution (50.0% - 0.6 per 1000 residents vs. 0.4 citywide).

- A total of 22,210 dispatched or self-initiated police calls were recorded from the community in 2011. This translates to 605 calls per 1000 residents.
- Dispatched or self-initiated calls from the community were 26.5% higher on a per capita basis than those received citywide (765.8 calls per 1000 residents vs. 605.0 calls citywide).

(8) Schools and School Performance

Within the Balsz community, there are five public schools (Balsz Elementary, Brunson-Lee Elementary, David Crockett Elementary, and Griffith Elementary, and Orangedale Junior High Preparatory), two charter schools (Academy of Excellence, Gateway Early Entry College High School), one private faith-based school (St. Theresa Catholic School), a community college (GateWay Community College), and at least four technical or trade schools.

The performance of public and state charter schools is assessed predominately via two mechanisms: the Adequate Yearly Performance (AYP) standards and Arizona Instrument to Measure Standards (AIMS) test scores. AYP is a set of school-level performance indicators prescribed by the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001

(<http://www.ade.az.gov/azlearns/aypdeterminations.asp>). AIMS tests generate performance measures on math, reading, writing and science, and are conducted annually (<http://www.azed.gov/research-evaluation/aims-assessment-results>). The Arizona Department of Education aggregates AIMS scores from each school annually into a summary “grade” for each school

(<http://www.ade.az.gov/azlearns/aypdeterminations.asp>), ranging from “A” to “E”.

Private schools use performance measures other than state of Arizona standards. In the case of St. Theresa, the Iowa Test of Basic Skills inventory is used.

In the sections that follow, basic descriptive information and performance measures for each school are summarized.

Balsz Elementary School

- Balsz Elementary, located at 4309 East Belleview, is one of four elementary schools of the Balsz Elementary School District. It is a Title 1 public school that serves 690 students in grades Kindergarten through 6th grade.
- The school did not achieve Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in 2011, signifying that it did not achieve the minimum levels of improvement determined by the State of Arizona in terms of student performance and other accountability measures.
- Balsz Elementary was given a C on the Arizona School Report Card in 2012.
- The school did meet AYP standards for attendance rate in 2011.
- In 2012, the majority of the students were Hispanic (69.1%). African American students comprised 19.5% of the school’s population, and 6.7% were white.

- Balsz Elementary School has been designated as an A+ school by the Arizona Educational Foundation's School Recognition Program.
- Faculty member Joy Weiss was named the 2010 Arizona Educational Foundation Teacher of the Year for 2010.
- The school has an active Art Club, which has created murals at the school to enhance school identity.

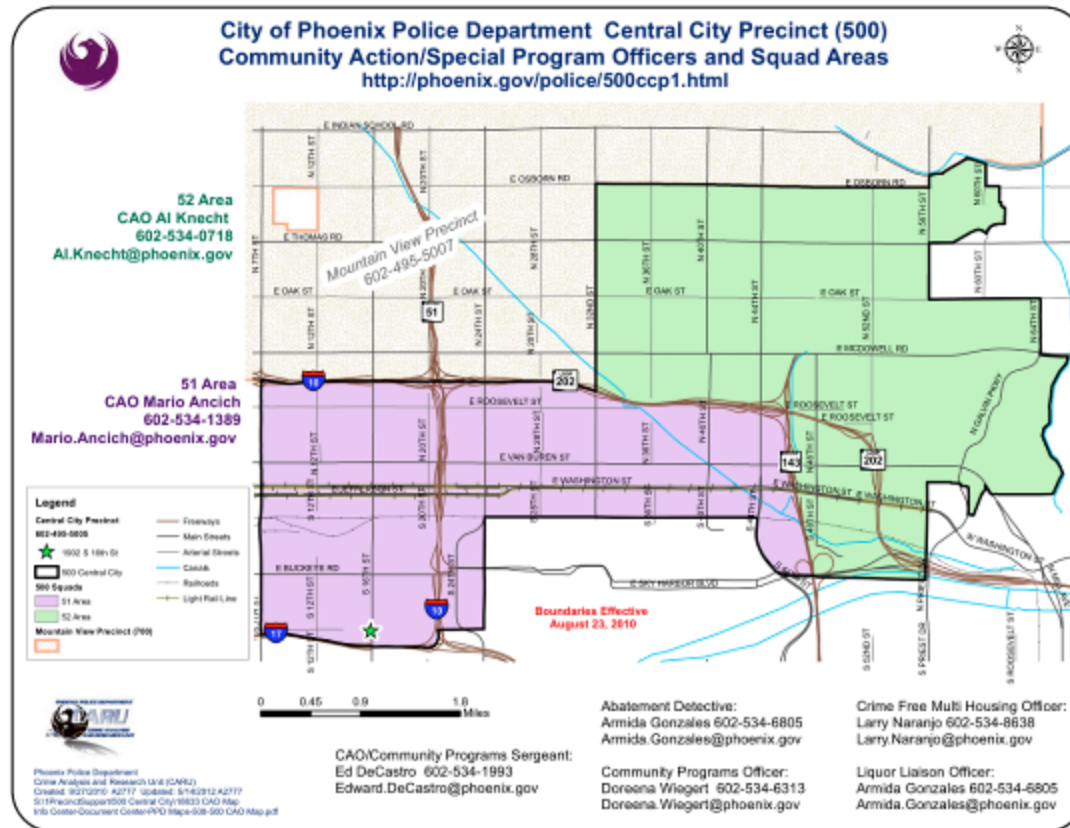

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Figure 10. City of Phoenix Police Department Central City Precinct (500) Community Action/Special Program Officers & Squad Serving the Balsz Community



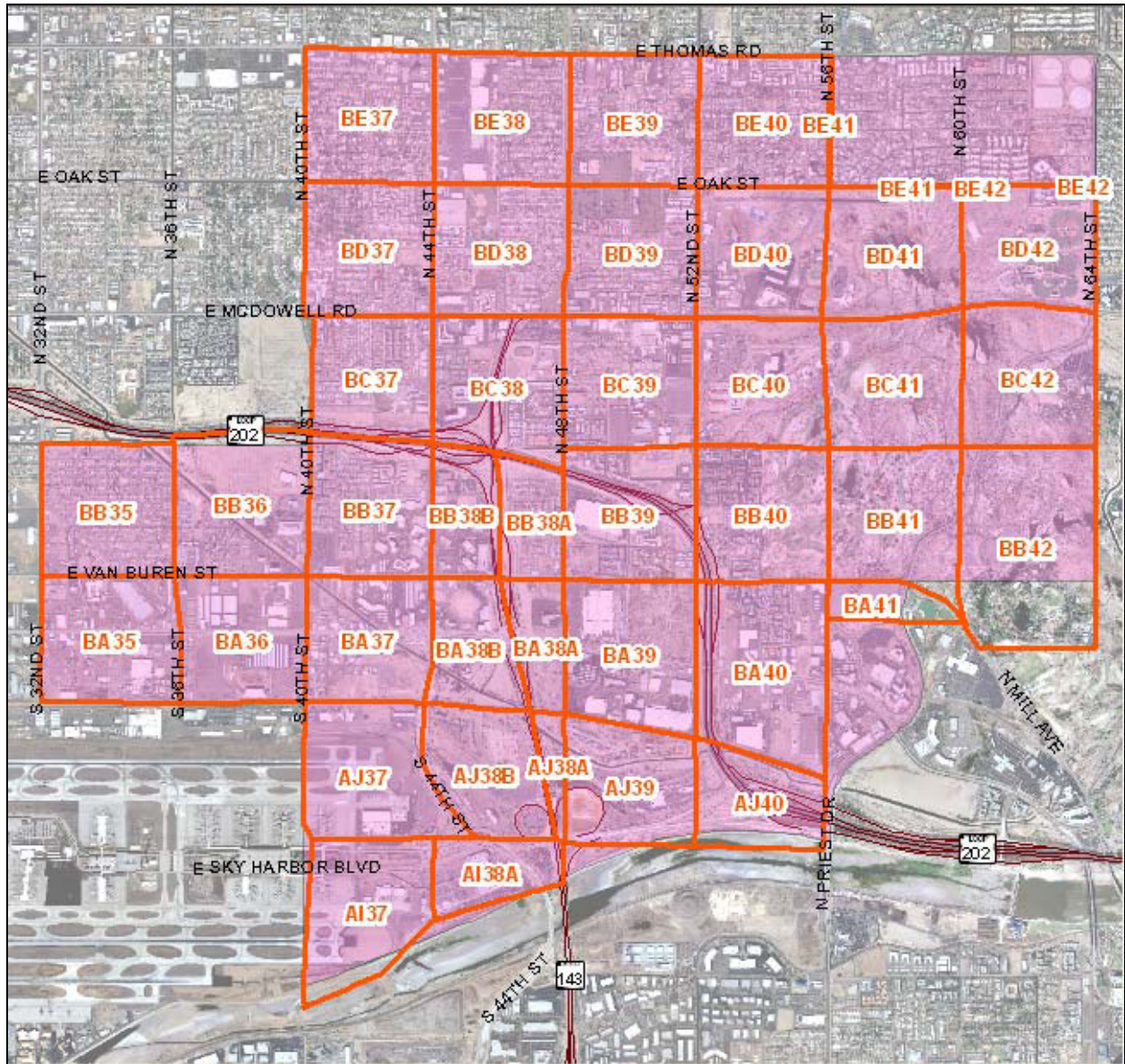

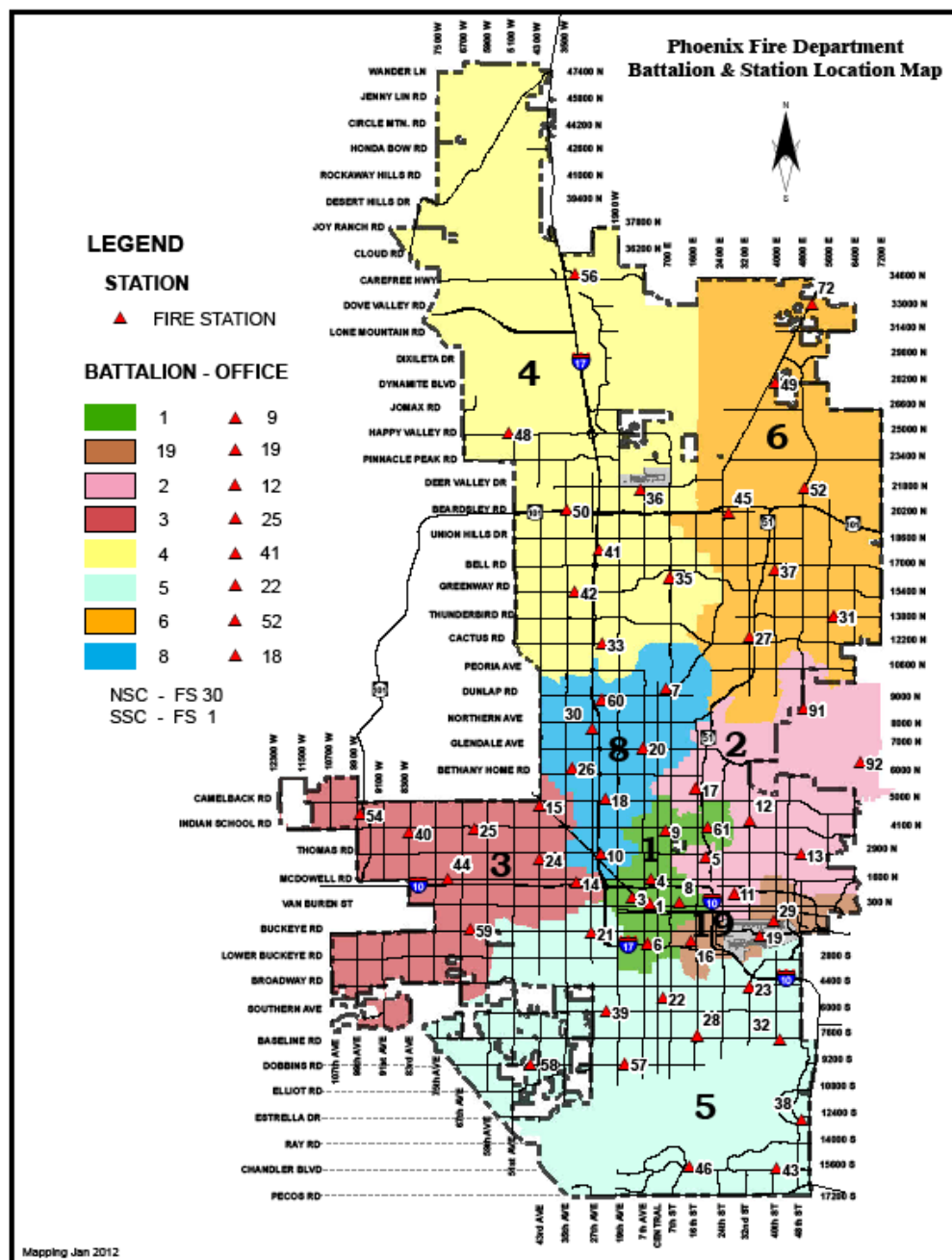

Fire Station 3 is part of the City of Phoenix Fire Department's Second Battalion (Figure 12), with Battalion offices at 4247 N. 32nd Street. 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City of Phoenix Village Planning Committees

The City of Phoenix is geographically divided into 15 Villages, each with its own Village Planning Committee. The Village Planning Committees serve as a link between the communities they serve and the City of Phoenix decision makers. The Committees assist the Planning Commission in the performance of its duties. Committee activities include: identifying areas or provisions of the General Plan text that need refinement and updating; identifying problems and needs related to implementation of the General Plan; defining in greater detail the intended future function, density and character of subareas of the village; and commenting on proposals for new zoning districts or land use districts.

The Balsz community is served by two Village Planning Committees: the Central City Village Planning Committee and the Camelback East Village Planning Committee. Geographically, the Central City Village Planning Committee represents the portion of the community west of the Grand Canal, and the Camelback East Village Planning Committee represents the portion of the community east of the Grand Canal (<http://phoenix.gov/planning/vpcentrl.html>).
